New logistics hub connects Hamburg Airport to Frankfurt Airport

Sterling's weekday shuttle service expedites aviation logistics with fast, reliable ground solutions



When it comes to aircraft on the ground (AOG) situations—every minute matters. That’s why Sterling is implementing logistics service hubs to speed the delivery of critical aircraft parts in key markets around the world. Our newest hub is based at Hamburg Airport (HAM). It operates a daily shuttle to Frankfurt Airport (FRA), supporting aerospace customers through the region’s largest OEM as well as other clients across the surrounding areas.

Reliable shuttle service speeds access to critical parts

Sterling opened its new logistics service hub at HAM to provide global operators with enhanced connectivity to FRA’s broader international flight network. The dedicated shuttle departs HAM every evening, Monday through Friday, arriving at FRA early the next morning to ensure shipments make the first flight out.

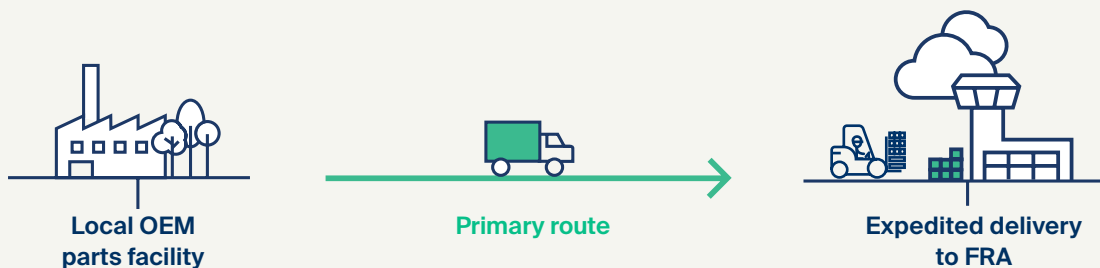
Sterling delivers the security and speed you need

The HAM shuttle service is managed by a dedicated team of aerospace logistics experts. Seamlessly integrated with the region’s leading OEM, they collect AOG shipments and transport them each evening from HAM to FRA for rapid global connection. This minimizes the risk of delays in HAM that could trigger missed connections in FRA, and ultimately slow the overall transit time.

- Improves shipment times with overnight driving to meet early cut-off times and first secure first-flight-out options
- Transfers shipments to FRA instead of tendering them at HAM, giving customers a larger network of global flight options and increased capacity flexibility
- Simplifies processes with our onsite Logistics Service Provider (LSP) collecting shipments directly from the region’s largest OEM and other aerospace clients within a 1.5 hour radius
- Gives commercial operators access to aircraft parts faster, reducing costs related to AOG situations
- Enhances security with comprehensive chain of custody protocols

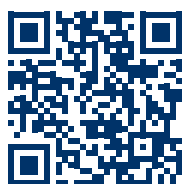


Fastest route for moving aircraft parts from HAM to FRA
